



HEALTH CARE ADMINISTRATION

This is a 2+2 degree. University of Northwestern Ohio students in the Medical Assisting associate degree will transfer into the degree completion program and complete their junior and senior years.

In addition, students from other regionally accredited institutions may transfer associate degrees in health-related areas into the 2+2 program. For example, Rhodes State College offers nine associate degrees in the health technology field: Dental Hygiene, Dietetics, Emergency Medical Technology - Paramedic, Medical Imaging Technology (Radiography and Computer Tomography), Nursing Technology, Occupational Therapy Assistant Technology, Physical Therapist Assistant Technology, Medical Assisting Technology, and Respiratory Care.

Students who transfer into the baccalaureate degree may have differing requirements to complete, based upon the general education and related courses the student has already taken.
