To better inform you about the preparations and precautions UNOH is taking to keep all students, staff, and faculty healthy this fall, UNOH has developed a set of resources located online at [www.unoh.edu/returntocampus](http://www.unoh.edu/returntocampus). These plans and procedures were developed by a team of university administrators, Allen County Public Health officials, and local healthcare providers. These policies also include guidelines that everyone within the UNOH community can use to keep themselves, and those around them, healthy as we return to face-to-face classes.

- 1) **Student Information** – This information details what students should review PRIOR to returning to campus. Policies, procedures, required materials and guidance is all listed here.
- 2) **Maintaining a Healthy and Safe Campus** – Learn about what steps UNOH has taken in classrooms, common areas, and facilities as well as advice about personal hygiene and mask wearing protocols.
- 3) **Reporting, Monitoring, and Identifying Potential Cases** – Details what students, faculty, and staff should do if they begin to experience symptoms of COVID-19. This page also outlines isolation and quarantine procedures in the event of a positive case on campus.
- 4) **Campus Life During COVID-19** – What will campus Housing be like? Student Activities? Support Services? Food Service? Get these questions answered here.
- 5) **Managing Off-Campus Travel** – Learn what types of travel will be permitted for students, faculty, and/or staff. You'll also see what protocols are in place if UNOH-owned vehicles are being used.
