On March 2, 2021, the Ohio Department of Health officially signed an addendum to the Requirements for Youth, Collegiate, Amateur, Club and Professional Sports order.

The updated order permits the following with regard to spectators for **outdoor facilities**:

- The maximum number of spectators permitted in any outdoor sports venue shall be 30% of fixed seated capacity.
- No congregating before or after the game is permitted.
- Spectators must wear masks at all times.
- Anyone experiencing symptoms must stay home.
- Six feet social distancing must be maintained between individuals and/or family groups (maximum group size is 6 people).

The updated order permits the following with regard to spectators for **indoor facilities**:

- The maximum number of spectators permitted in any indoor sports venue shall be 25% of fixed seated capacity.
- No congregating before or after the game is permitted.
- Spectators must wear masks at all times.
- Anyone experiencing symptoms must stay home.
- Six feet social distancing must be maintained between individuals and/or family groups (maximum group size is 4 people).

Beginning March 3, 2021, UNOH will adopt the policies and requirements of this amended order. All coaching staff will be responsible for overseeing the facial covering requirement and maximum capacity allowed at their facility. Coaches must also maintain a guest or pass list identifying who will be attending and what group/pod they will be sitting with if not alone. Coaches will keep a record of this pass list for each home game until the season is over.
