Dear UNOH Family,

As the University of Northwestern Ohio progresses through its fall terms, we are announcing a newly launched Coronavirus Dashboard today in order to maintain our commitment to transparency during this public health emergency. The dashboard, which will be updated weekly and can be accessed at <https://www.unoh.edu/returntocampus/dashboard.html>, tracks COVID-19 cases and quarantines among both students and employees. The dashboard encompasses any active or resolved cases and quarantines since August 24, 2020 when UNOH resumed face-to-face instruction. Active Cases are those individuals who have tested positive during that week. Currently Quarantined numbers reflect those who are currently quarantined either at home or on campus due to a positive test or exposure to a positive case.

It is the university's hope that students, employees, and their families utilize this dashboard as a source of accurate information as all constituencies work together to operate in a safe and responsible manner during this pandemic.

The University of Northwestern Ohio continues to follow all federal, state, and local guidelines to help mitigate the spread of COVID-19. Anyone experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, which include fever, shortness of breath, muscle aches or a cough, headache, diarrhea, sore throat, or loss of taste or smell, should immediately contact their supervisor or instructor then seek medical attention for evaluation and stay home until cleared to return to campus.
