After careful consideration, the University of Northwestern Ohio's Cabinet has voted to postpone the start of Winter Quarter and January Session to January 11, 2021 due to concerns about holiday travel and COVID-19 spread. This one-week delay allows students ample time to spend the holidays with family if they so choose. The additional days off will also give students the opportunity to self-quarantine, either at home or in off-campus housing, for two full weeks after the Christmas holiday in order to monitor any potential symptoms that may appear following travel prior to the start of the next academic term.

As a result of the delayed start, spring break will be adjusted so the University can remain on schedule for the rest of the academic year. The adjustment to the start of Winter Quarter and January Session will impact start and end dates of the following terms:

**College of Applied Technologies:**

- January Session: 1/11/2021 – 2/18/2021
- February Session: 2/22/2021 – 3/25/2021 \*May include Fridays if days are missed due to inclement weather cancellations\*
- March Session: 3/29/2021 – 5/6/2021 \*No school 4/1/2021 – 4/6/2021 for Easter break\*

**Colleges of Business, Health Professions, and Occupational Professions and Graduate College:**

- Winter Quarter: 1/11/2021 – 3/19/2021. Final Exams 3/22/2021 – 3/24/2021 \*Spring Break is 3/25/2021 – 4/5/2021\*

Due to the extended holiday break, UNOH offices will now be closed on December 28 & 29, 2020.
