

Dear UNOH Family,

Due to revised guidance from the CDC the time has come for an update to our isolation and quarantine requirements on campus. **The following changes are in effect beginning July 1, 2022.**

For individuals who test POSITIVE for COVID-19:

Vaccination Status	Symptoms	Time in Isolation	Masks required following isolation
Everyone, regardless of Vaccination Status	Asymptomatic	A minimum of 5 days as long as you remain asymptomatic	5 days after isolation
	Symptomatic	If symptoms improve by Day 5, can return on day 6. If symptoms persist, isolate for a total of 10 days	Follow local guidelines

For individuals who are identified as a Trace Contact of a positive COVID-19 case:

Vaccination Status	Symptoms	Time in Quarantine	Masks required following quarantine
<b>Fully Vaccinated &amp; Up to Date</b> *2-doses of Pfizer/Moderna + Booster if aged 12-49 * 2-doses of Pfizer/Moderna + 2 boosters if 50 years old or older *Johnson & Johnson plus a booster of Pfizer/Moderna if aged 12-49 *Johnson & Johnson + 2 boosters if 50 years old or older	Asymptomatic	None required – Test on day 5 if possible.	10 days after exposure
	Symptomatic	If symptoms develop, stay home and get a test. Remain at home until results are returned. If test is positive, see Isolation chart above.	10 days after exposure
<b>Fully Vaccinated</b> *2-doses of Pfizer/Moderna and no booster if aged 12-49 * 2-doses of Pfizer/Moderna + 1 booster if 50 years old or older *Johnson & Johnson and no booster of Pfizer/Moderna if aged 12-49 *Johnson & Johnson + 1 booster if 50 years old or older	Asymptomatic	5 days	5 days after quarantine
	Symptomatic	5 days – Take test on day 5 after exposure. If test is negative, can be released. If test is positive, see Isolation chart above.	5 days after quarantine
Unvaccinated	Asymptomatic	At least 5 days – Take a test on day 5 after exposure. If test is negative, can be released. If test is positive, see Isolation chart above.	5 days after quarantine

	Symptomatic	10 days – Take a test on day 5, 6, or 7, after exposure. If test is negative, can be released. If test is positive, see Isolation chart above.	Follow local guidelines

Students who are identified as a positive case or trace contact must notify Student Success at [StudentSuccess@unoh.edu](mailto:StudentSuccess@unoh.edu). They will work with you to identify the number of days you must quarantine. You must also communicate with your instructor or professor about your absence and work on making up any missed assignments. Each class and student may have different accommodations due to the nature of assignments.

Students will need to make their own arrangements for isolation and quarantine space. All students should have a personal COVID-19 plan, confirmed with your family, in the event of illness. If you are unable to travel home (due to travel restrictions or other mitigating circumstances), the University will work to arrange quarantine housing for you.

Employees who are identified as a positive case or trace contact must notify Human Resources at [HR@unoh.edu](mailto:HR@unoh.edu). HR will work with you to identify the number of days you must quarantine and communicate with your supervisor accordingly.

UNOH administration is basing all of these decisions on public health guidance, in partnership with state and local health agencies.
