### **College of Applied Technologies –**

**June Session will begin as scheduled on June 29, 2020.**

**Courses will continue to be delivered remotely in a web-enhanced format** as recommended by local, state, and federal agencies. Students will be assigned general education courses required as part of their program. **Course content will be available to preview beginning on June 26, 2020.** Interaction with your instructor will start on June 29<sup>th</sup>.

Students who took a hiatus in March and/or May Session will have that hiatus extended into the June Session. Those on a hiatus who have general education classes left in their program, can ask to be reinstated and scheduled for the June Session if they choose to do so. **If students have completed all of their general education requirements, they will be scheduled for their next technical class to start on August 24, 2020.** If this date should change, we will communicate it as soon as possible.

### **Colleges of: Business, Health Professions, and Occupational Professions –**

**Summer Quarter will begin as scheduled on July 6, 2020.**

Traditional classes in Summer Quarter will **continue to be delivered remotely in a web-enhanced format.** This means that you will still have live meetings with your instructor through the 'Web Enhanced' tab on the MyUNOH portal. Course content will be available to review beginning on July 3<sup>rd</sup>. If you wish to adjust your Summer Quarter schedule, you can use online registration within Student Planning during the Late Registration Period June 19-25 and the Late Adjustment Period July 3-5. There will be no additional tuition charges for this web-enhanced format. **If, however, you choose to transition to a Virtual College course (no live meetings at a designated time), tuition will align with the Virtual College rate.**
